ANZ:

Supply ePOS Terminal ID (11 digits starting with "0250..."). No terminal ID required.

Commonwealth:

Merchant ID Only (16 digits starting with 5353109...) No Terminal ID required.

National Australia Bank:

Merchant ID (8 digits, referred to as the EB number on your forms) and a Terminal ID (6 digits of the form "YxT..." where x is usually the same as first digit of Merchant ID; Terminal ID can also be of the form "Xabcde" where a-e can be any number).

Westpac:

Merchant ID Only (8 digits generally starting with "22").

St George/Bank SA:

Merchant ID (15 digits starting with "05799820...") and an OCA Terminal ID (8 digits, generally starting with "008...")

BankWest:

Merchant ID Only (8 digits, generally of the form "4...101")
